School Health Information

Kindergarten roundup was held on Friday, March 22nd. We had 29 children participate this year. It is always great to see all those young faces excited (and some nervous) about starting school in the fall.

Third and fourth graders will soon be finished participating in the Live Healthy Iowa Kids program. March was National Nutrition Month and I visited each of the K-4 classrooms. We talked about the "My Plate" dietary guidelines, making healthier food choices and the importance of being more physically active. We also discussed food portions and nutrition labels. If you notice your children being more active and eating healthier, please encourage them to do so.

The freshmen Health classes will soon be finished with their CPR/AED/First Aid course. If your child has become certified in CPR vs. being trained in CPR, this means they have met all the course requirements and will be certified for 2 years, but will take a refresher class annually. If your child did not meet all the course requirements, they still have become CPR "trained", which became a graduation requirement in 2012.

The tenth grade Biology students participated in a class experiment with my assistance. We tested their blood to see what blood type they had. I emphasized that the test we were doing was not 100% accurate. Tenth and 11th grade students will be having CPR refresher classes in April.

Mass sports physical day at the Kingsley Medical Clinic has been set for Wednesday, May 8th. Informational letters with a blank physical form will be sent out in the mail to parents of all 6-12th grade students. I will start doing pre-screenings in early April.

IF YOUR CHILD WILL BE GETTING THEIR PHYSICAL DONE ON MAY 8TH AT THE KINGSLEY MEDICAL CLINIC, THEY WILL NEED TO SEE ME WITH THEIR COMPLETED AND SIGNED SPORTS PHYSICAL FORM BEFORE APRIL 29TH, FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS. High school students will be responsible to get their own prescreening done with me. I will have posted days and times available to see them. They need to bring their COMPLETED AND SIGNED physical form to me before I will do their prescreening.

I WILL BE DOING PRESCREENINGS IN THE MIDDLE SCHOOL ON TUESDAY, APRIL 30TH. THOSE ATHLETES WILL NEED TO TURN IN THEIR COMPLETED AND SIGNED FORM TO MRS WASHBURN BEFORE APRIL 29TH. I WILL NOT BE DOING PRESCREENINGS IN THE MIDDLE SCHOOL ON ANY OTHER DAY.

The fee of \$25 for the Kingsley Medical Clinic to do the physical can be turned into me ahead of time or can be brought on May 8th to the physician's office. Your child WILL NOT BE SEEN MAY 8th if they do not have the fee. Please call me if you have any questions regarding sports physicals. .

Students were invited to participate in the day by signing a poster with the Spread the Word to End the Word pledge. "I am very pleased to see how many students took part in the Spread the Word to End the Word awareness day by signing the poster. My hope is that our students become aware that the R-Word is hurtful, will refrain from using it, and will encourage others to stop using it." New Immunization Requirement for All Students Entering 7th Grade Beginning with the 2013-2014 School Year

The Iowa Department of Public Health, Immunization Program has made a change to the Iowa Administrative Code to require a Tdap vaccination for all adolescents enrolled in secondary school. It will be effective beginning with the 2013-2014 school year. The new language is intended to require adolescents entering 7th grade (approximately 13 years of age) to have one dose of the Tdap vaccine.

This requirement will help Iowa achieve and maintain high vaccination adolescent coverage levels while reducing the number of pertussis (whooping cough) cases occurring annually in Iowa. There are approximately 417% more persons with pertussis disease this year compared to the average of the past five years (the five year average is 193; 1156 cases were reported for 2012 through August of 2012).

As you schedule physicals for athletics or if you are in your physician's office this spring or summer, please ask about this booster vaccine. Documentation of the Tdap vaccine on the Certificate of Immunization will need to be provided to the middle school nurse prior to the first day of school.
