Kick-off assemblies were held in the elementary, middle school and high school on March 25, 2013. Students were encouraged to donate their spare change for this fundraiser. Collection boxes were also placed in several businesses in the community. We are proud to announce that we raised \$1320.67 to donate to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society. School Health Information

April was a busy month getting many of the 6-12th grade students prescreened for sports physical day. The date that mass physicals will be done at the Kingsley Medical Clinic is Wednesday, May 8th from 8-12 noon. If you have chosen to get your child's physical done by your own physician, the forms need to be turned into the main office by Friday, August 2nd.

The 3rd and 4th graders have completed the Live Healthy Iowa Kids program. Hopefully they have learned to make some healthier food choices and be more physically active with this program. The K-4th grade students will be celebrating Go the Distance Day on Friday May, 3rd from approximately 1:40-3 pm. Before participating in our activity, each class is to recite a motto about eating healthier and being more active. The 3rd and 4th grade classes are creating the motto. This year we will be walking around the proximity of the school on the trail. Informational letters have been sent home with all K-4 students. We will finish the afternoon with health snacks. Afterwards, I will submit a report about our event and our school will be put into a drawing for monetary prizes to be used for PE or playground equipment.

The 5th graders were given a presentation called "Safe Wheels". It is a program sponsored by the Siouxland Chapter of the American Red Cross and given by an Iowa State Trooper. They are taught basic bike and vehicle safety.

The 9th graders have completed their CPR/AED/ First Aid course during Health classes. The 10th graders have completed a CPR/AED skills refresher class and the 11th graders have retrained in CPR/AED skills. Those eligible for certification have been given their wallet certification cards.

I will soon be sending out informational letters and a certificate of dental screening form to all parents of 8th grade students. This is the 5th year that the dental screening is a requirement for all students entering kindergarten and 9th grade. Please take the dental screening certificate to your dentist. Have them fill it out after an exam over the summer and return it to the school in the fall. Have a safe and enjoyable summer vacation!

New Immunization Requirement for All Students Entering 7th Grade Beginning with the 2013-2014 School Year

The Iowa Department of Public Health, Immunization Program has made a change to the Iowa Administrative Code to require a Tdap vaccination for all adolescents enrolled in secondary school. It will be effective beginning with the 2013-2014 school year. The new language is intended to require adolescents entering 7th grade (approximately 13 years of age) to have one dose of the Tdap vaccine.

This requirement will help Iowa achieve and maintain high vaccination adolescent coverage levels while reducing the number of pertussis (whooping cough) cases occurring annually in Iowa. There are approximately 417% more persons with pertussis disease this year compared to the average of the past five years (the five year average is 193; 1156 cases were reported for 2012 through August of 2012).

As you schedule physicals for athletics or if you are in your physician's office this spring or summer, please ask about this booster vaccine. Documentation of the Tdap vaccine on the Certificate of Immunization will need to be provided to the middle school nurse prior to the first day of school.

FALL 2012 PSEO CLASSES:

Students are in the process of registering for PSEO classes. Students will need to complete their "I Have A Plan Iowa" Program and especially the four year plan before they can register for PSEO classes.

WITCC highly recommends students set up their accounts the week prior to the start of online classes. Students that take time to go through the tutorial before the class begins will have a greater chance of success with online classes. There are many fine details explained in the tutorial to help students be successful with their classes. One tip to remember is the pop up blocker must be turned off on all toolbars before submitting assignments and tests. Students also need to wait for a box that says "Assignment was successfully submitted" before closing out of that area.

ACT Tests

Juniors planning to attend a 4 year college or university will need to take an ACT test before they will be accepted into a college. To register for ACT's, go to www.actstudent.org and complete the registration forms. There is a September test and the students planning to take their test in September will need to register by early August. Remember to release your scores to our high school for your transcripts and releasing those scores after you take the test, will require an additional fee. Colleges always take the highest ACT score on your transcript or from the ACT organization. Also, the University of Iowa, Iowa State University, and the University of Northern Iowa will only accept ACT scores sent directly to them from the ACT organization. They will not take ACT's off a high school transcript.

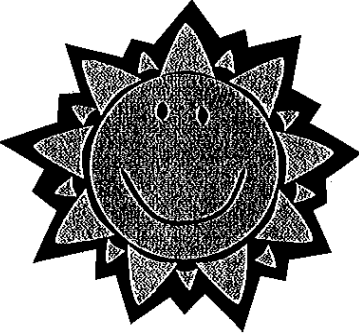
